\$500 AWARD**



This scholarship was established to provide assistance to a high school senior girl in the Alliance area to further her education. This includes senior girls from Alliance, Marlinton, Sebring, and West Branch High Schools, as well as St. Thomas Aquinas senior girls with an Alliance home mailing address. There shall be no discrimination based on race or religion.

1. REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Show financial need.
- b. Be a graduating senior girl.
- c. Attend one of the high schools listed above.
- d. Maintain at least 3.0 cumulative G.P.A.
- e. Use award to further post high school education in a recognized institution.
- f. Show evidence indicating potential success in college.
- g. Demonstrate good character and integrity.
- h. Demonstrate academic scholarship achievement, extracurricular activities including community service, and leadership abilities.
- i. Complete and submit the application by the deadline listed below including:
  - i. Two (2) recommendations
  - ii. A listing of activities
  - iii. An essay
  - iv. An official school transcript including SAT or ACT score

2. AWARDING:

- a. The Scholarship may be announced at the YWCA Annual Dinner and/or the Senior Awards Program at the recipient's school.
- b. The Scholarship funds may be used for tuition at accredited colleges or universities within the continental United States. If all tuition is paid by other sources, the scholarship money may be used for books, or room and board.
- c. In case of a tie, the Committee may split the award equally between two applicants.
